Knuckleduster; a band of metal or other hard material worn on one or more fingers, and designed to cause injury, and any weapon incorporating a knuckleduster.



Handclaw; a band of metal or other hard material from which a number of sharp spikes protrude, and worn around the hand.



Belt Buckle Knife; a buckle which incorporates or conceals a knife.



Push Dagger; a knife the handle of which fits within a clenched fist and the blade of which protrudes from between two fingers.



Hollow Kubotan; a cylindrical container containing a number of sharp spikes.



Footclaw; a bar of metal or other hard material from which a number of sharp spikes protrude, and worn strapped to the foot.



Flick Knives; any knife that opens automatically from a closed position, or partially opened position, to a fully opened position by means of any manual pressure that is applied to a button, spring or other device which is contained either within the knife or is attached to the knife.



Cyclone/Spiral Knives; a weapon comprised of a handle with a blade with two or more cutting edges, each of which forms a helix and a sharp point at the end of the blade.



Curved Sword; a sword with a curved blade of 50 centimetres or over in length and for the purposes of this sub-paragraph, the length of the blade shall be the straight line distance from the top of the handle to the tip of the blade.



Shuriken/Death Star; a hard non-flexible plate having three or more sharp radiating points and designed to be thrown.



Balisong/Butterfly Knife; a blade enclosed by its handle, which is designed to split down the middle, without the operation of a spring or other mechanical means, to reveal the blade.



Telescopic Truncheon; a truncheon which extends automatically by hand pressure applied to a button, spring or other device in or attached to its handle.



Blowpope/Blow Gun; a hollow tube out of which hard pellets or darts are shot by the use of breath.



Kusari Gama; a length of rope, cord, wire or chain fastened at one end to a sickle.



Kyoketsu Shoge; a length of rope, cord, wire or chain fastened at one end to a hooked knife.



Manrikigusari/Kusari; a length of rope, cord, wire or chain fastened at each end to a hard weight or hand grip.



Swordstick; a hollow walking-stick or cane containing a blade which may be used as a sword.



Zombie Knives; a knife with a cutting edge, a serrated edge and images or words suggesting it is used for violence. All elements need to be present.

Kubotan Gwag; cynhwysydd siâp silindr sy'n cynnwys nifer o bigau miniog.



Crafanc troed; cleddyf gyda llafn crwm 50 centimedr neu'n fwy o hyd. At ddibenion yr is-baragraff hwn, bydd hyd y llafn yn bellter llinell syth o ben y carn i ben y llafn.



Cyllyll clec; unrhyw gyllell sy'n agor yn awtomatig o safle caeedig, neu le sy'n rhannol agored, i le cwbl agored drwy bwyo bo twm, sbring neu declyn arall a geir un ai o fewn y gyllell neu sydd yn sownd i'r gyllell.



Cyllyll Troellog; arf sy'n cynnwys carn gyda llafn gydag ymyl dorri neu ddwy, mae pob un yn ffurio troell a phwynt miniog ar ddiwedd y llafn.



Cleddyf Crwm; cleddyf gyda llafn crwm 50 centimedr neu'n fwy o hyd. At ddibenion yr is-baragraff hwn, bydd hyd y llafn yn bellter llinell syth o ben y carn i ben y llafn.



Shuriken/Seren Farwolaeth; plât anhyblyg caled gyda thri phwynt ymledol miniog neu fwy ac sydd wedi'i ddylunio er mwyn cael ei daflu.



Balisong/Cyllell Pili Pala; llafn gaeedig gan ei garn, sydd wedi'i ddylunio er mwyn rhannu i lawr y canol, heb sbring neu ffordd fecanyddol arall, er mwyn datgelur llafn.



Pastwn Telesgopig; pastwn sy'n ymestyn yn awtomatig wrth bwyo bo twm, sbring neu declyn arall sydd yn sownd i'w garn.



Chwythbib; pibell wag o lle saethir haels caled neu ddartiau drwy ddefnyddio anadl.



Kusari Gama; hyd o raff, cortyn, gwifren neu gadwyn wedi'u clymu ar un pen o gryman.



Kyoketsu Shoge; hyd o raff, cortyn, gwifren neu gadwyn wedi'u clymu ar un pen i gyllell fachog.



Manrikigusari/Kusari; hyd o raff, cortyn, gwifren neu gadwyn wedi'u clymu ar un pen o bwysau caled neu garn llaw.



Ffon gleddyf; ffon gerdded wag yn cynnwys llafn a ellid ei defnyddio fel cleddyf.



Cyllyll Sombi; cyllell gydag ymyl dorri, ymyl ddanheddog a lluniau neu eiriau sy'n awgrymu y'i defnyddir ar gyfer traís.
